

## ONTABA's 2020 Annual Conference FAQ's

### Can I purchase a ticket to attend one day of the conference?

We are not offering one day registrations. We have consent to share all of the invited speakers' talks for one month on the Whova platform. Pending consent of the other presenters, talks will be available for one year.

### Is the conference going to be recorded?

Yes! Attendees will have access to invited speakers' talks for one month. All other presentations will be available for one year on the Whova platform, pending the consent of presenters.

### What topics will be covered at the conference?

The presentation topics this year are focused on ethics/supervision, behaviour analysis and artificial intelligence, best practices for online learning, and race/diversity. There will be 4 invited speakers as well as posters and symposia presentations, offering a wide variety of topics in the field. ### Is there a poster session option only for the conference?

Ticket registration options include 2-day registration for the event this year because attendees will have access to talks on-demand after the event for one year for presentations (for speakers who consent) and one month for keynote speakers' talks.

### If I am presenting a poster do I need to attend the conference?

If your poster is accepted and you are not able to attend, you can assign a new presenter who can register for the conference or you can withdraw your submission. ### **How do I sign up for the AGM?**
