Frequently Asked Questions

Presentations

1. What topics will be covered at the conference? The presentation topics for this year are as follows:

Dr. Mahshid Ghaemmaghami – Towards Trauma-Informed, Compassionate Applied Behavior Analysis: Key Values and Assumptions

Dr. Patrick McGreevy – Issues and Procedures that are not Part of the Mainstream of Behavior Analysis

Dr. Mary Jane Weiss – Effective Collaboration: Building Bridges, Breaking Barriers, and Enhancing Outcomes

Dr. Peter Gerhardt – Changing the Behavior of Behavior Analysts to Improve Outcomes in Autistic Adults

- 2. If I attend virtually, do I get to watch all presentations for the day? Unfortunately, we will not be able to live-stream all presentations. All invited speakers will be live-streamed and some of the breakout will also be live-streamed. At this time, we are unable to confirm which breakout sessions will be recorded.
- If I am presenting a poster do I need to attend the conference? No, you can purchase a "poster only" option. However, this is only available for inperson attendees.

Virtual attendees must purchase a full-day registration, and are unable to purchase a poster session only registration.

If your poster is accepted and you are not able to attend, you can assign a new presenter who can register for the conference or you can withdraw your submission. We ask that you communicate any changes to the presenter or authors by sending an email to conference@ontaba.org. Please see the list of fees below. If you are not already an ONTABA member, the cost of registration is lower if you become a member.

4. Is the conference going to be recorded?

Some talks may be recorded, however, not all presentations will be. Please understand that not all speakers (including our invited speakers and those presenting in breakout sessions) are comfortable with being recorded.

Registration

1. Can I purchase a ticket to attend one day of the conference? Absolutely, there are Thursday-only and Friday-only ticket options to purchase.

2. When does early bird discount end?

This ends at 11:59 pm on November 7th, 2022.

3. How can I get a group discount?

To receive a 10% group discount, register 5 or more participants at one time. Enter the names and email addresses of each registrant and follow the prompts on the registration page for information on membership status and CEUs. Next, click "add registrant" to add up to 5 or more participants and repeat.

4. Do you require BCBA numbers prior to the conference?

If you are an ONTABA member, you will automatically qualify for CEUs for free. If you are not an ONTABA member, you will need to purchase one CEU when you register. We will be using the CEU Helper App (similar to previous years) to allow you to input your BCBA number and check-in/check-out of each presentation that offers CEUs. For this reason, we won't need your BCBA number upon registration.

5. How many CEUs do I need to purchase?

If you are an ONTABA member, you will be able to collect CEU's for free. When you register, click add only one CEU to your cart, regardless of the number of people you are registering.

If you are not an ONTABA member, you will need to purchase one CEU per attendee.

6. Is there a poster session option only for the conference?

Yes, all in-person attendees may purchase a poster session only conference. This is event will occur during the evening for the Wine and Cheese night.

If you are attending virtually, you may only purchase a full-day ticket options. However, poster presenters who have agreed to record a virtual presentation will be available for viewing.

7. How do I sign up for the AGM?

You do not need to attend the conference to attend the AGM as it is open to all ONTABA members. To register, please see membership information on our website.

Collecting CEUs

1. How many CEUs do I need to purchase?

Please refer to "Registration" section for this question. If you are an ONTABA member, you will be able to collect CEU's for free. When you register, click add only one CEU to your cart, regardless of the number of people you are registering.

If you are not an ONTABA member, you will need to purchase one CEU per attendee.

2. How will we be collecting CEUs?

Similar to previous years, we will be using the app "CEU Helper".

3. What is CEU Helper?

CEUHelper is a web/mobile application for obtaining and tracking Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB) CEUs, which will be used to manage and collect CEUs at the ONTABA Annual Conference.

Virtual Attendees

1. What platform will we be using?

Similar to our virtual conference in 2021, we will be using WHOVA.

2. What is Whova?

WHOVA is an all-in-one event management platform that helps attendees manage a virtual conference by providing networking opportunities. Event attendees use the WHOVA app to get the most out of events. Specifically, attendees can browse event brochures, agendas, and set personalized schedules. Further, the platform allows attendees to network with other attendees before, during, and after the event!
