As an Registered Behaviour Technician at CBI Health Specialized Community Services (ON), you will be responsible for implementing intervention plans, recording data and documenting session notes. As an RBT you will report to the Clinical Manager and will receive ongoing supervision from a Board Certified Behaviour Analyst.

The clients supported are diagnosed with ASD, other DDs, other learning/behavioural needs and may also have mental health challenges. Your clients will consist primarily of children, youth and young adults. Experience with adults and managing severe problem behaviour (aggression, self-injury, property damage) is an asset. Experience collaborating with community partners in group homes and/or hospital settings is also an asset.

- Works directly with individuals with complex behavioural needs such individuals with an Autism, ID, DD diagnosis and/or other mental health conditions (may include dual diagnosis)

- Keeping session notes and behaviour tracking up to date
- Assist in development of assessment and intervention plans
- Ongoing monitoring of behaviour support plans
- Encourage and assist clients to participate in social, educational and/or recreational activities
